

2. Set your camera lens to its widest aperture. Use the aperture priority mode (Av). Move the camera as close to the chart as possible, while the AF system can still focus on the chart, then back it off a little . Use a remote or the timer of the camera so that you don't press the shutter release with your finger. (This is to avoid any movement of the camera) Disengage the (SR) Shake Reduction system. Take the picture. Check if the center is in perfect focus on the monitor or by printing the picture. Don't worry so much about the depth of field. You need to concentrate on the center line in the middle of the chart. If it is in focus, everything is fine. The lines below and above the center line should gradually and proportionnally get out of focus. It should be evident at that point if your lens has back or front focus problems. If it does, refer to the Custom Menu setting No. 35 (AF

Adjustment)

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
